In addition to the above eleven muses this booklet contains the following four Muses and three Commentaries.

Muses

(At present an additional four in number.)

- A muse about the forms of Network required to spread effectively a message throughout society. This is a philosophical look at the pros and cons of several types. It is not a technical discussion about the systems, more a consideration of their effectiveness and limitations.
- A Muse about the possible form of our Personal Spiritual World; its relationship with Anima Loci and a Universal Soul. This will be revised to include the concept of an original reality in which our created reality is no more than a ripple.
- This could be considered is an extension of the previous Muse to reflect upon the types and strengths of Relationships that exist within society: it is concerned more with non-physical aspects of relationship.
- This takes the relationships discussed in the previous muse and considers a possible way in which the structure and customs of Society may have evolved.

The Commentaries

The following three commentaries are little different from the muses: they differ only in that they were instigated by reactions to an actual event in the case of (1); the contents of an old paperback for (2); and pure speculation in the case of (3).

- 1) The Healing: The prime discussion concerns an experience we had with one of our cats who on face value was saved from being put to sleep by the intervention of a distance Healer.
- 2) Proportion and Measure: The main concern of this discussion is to show that almost all historical units of measure were related to Nature and natural process. The general conversion to Metric Units – on face value of greater convenience – may have resulted in the weakening of our connections with Nature.
- 3) The Migrations: There is a relative consensus about the Out-of-Africa hypothesis some 60,000 years ago. This discussion considers the possibility of other credible options. My speculations on this subject pre-dated the delving that resulted in Booklet Part one and then Part Two. It is my intention to eventually combine these into a single Book that will stand as a precursor to a sequel dealing with the Nature Faiths. That is if I live long enough.

It is my intention to combine this booklet with booklets two and three in order to present two Books that will then be included in the Book Section.

Until that happens I shall attempt to make the original booklets available in hard copy as well as for download.
